



DENTAL NETWORK

The Dental Network aims to help students obtain quality dental care at the lowest possible cost. This Network is comprised of dentists who take into consideration the precarious financial situation of students and have agreed to provide them with a rebate based on the Provincial Dental Fee Guide cost for General Practitioners.

- ► The only people who profit from this reduction are the students. Neither we nor the insurance company receive any benefit whatsoever from the discount granted to students. The economic conditions under which students live do not allow them to benefit from regular dental care unless they are insured. Thanks to the Dental Network, students can better afford their dental care.
- ▶ It is also important that when the dentists supply a service to students, they continue to respect the highest standards of their profession. They must offer their usual standard and quality of professional services at all times, from arranging appointments to performing dental procedures.
- ▶ In order to avoid problems with claims, whether submitted by the student or the dentist, effective communication between the dentist and the student is essential. Please take the time to explain to the student the work that has been carried out during their visit and the corresponding codes that appear on the claim form.

DENTAL NETWORK PROCESS

INITIAL PATIENT CONTACT

Each student accessing the Network must present their valid student identification card to the dentist to be eligible for the reduced rates of the Network. Family members enrolled in the student's Plan will also use the student identification card to access the Network.

NETWORK REDUCTION

The cost to the student accessing a Network dentist is the fee of the procedure according to the Provincial Dental Fee Guide for General Practitioners minus the Network reduction. The Provincial Dental Fee Guide is updated every year.

The process for administering the reduction depends on whether the dentist is part of the Studentcare Network or the Gallivan Network. See the following page for details.

Please note that the dentist is free to offer a larger discount than that required by the Network. The Dental Network Reduction rates are listed below:

ADMINISTERING THE NETWORK REDUCTION

Studentcare Network dentists:

The Network reduction must take place up front; the dental office will record the reduced fee on the claim form. Therefore, for a \$100 basic service (eligible for a 20% reduction), \$80 should be charged to the student and written on the claim form. In the case of a student who has 80% coverage for basic services, they will be reimbursed 80% of the cost of the procedure as defined by the Provincial Dental Fee Guide for General Practitioners, rather than 80% of the reduced fee. As a result, the student is reimbursed \$80 (essentially 100% coverage).

Gallivan Network dentists:

The dental office will record the full fee as per the Provincial Dental Fee Guide in their claim to the insurer, and the Network reduction will be written off afterward. Therefore, for a \$100 basic service (eligible for a 20% reduction), \$100 should be written on the claim form. The dentist will then apply the 20% reduction to the amount actually charged to the student, meaning that the student only pays \$80.

CLAIMING PROCEDURE

WITH PAY DIRECT

Step 1: Confirm Coverage

Ask to see the student ID card.

Step 2: Fill Out Claim Form

- ▶ Dentist fills out claim form.
- ► Student fills out personal information section.
- ▶ Dentist ensures student signs the following: the section authorizing the assignment of benefits to the dentist, the section regarding the release of information, and the declaration at the bottom of the page.
- Dentist sends completed form to insurance company.

NOTE: The dentist must always indicate the total fee for the treatment as well as the dental procedural codes for the services provided on the claim form. The insurance company only uses the codes to process claims. For Studentcare Network dentists, the Network reduction must take place up front; the dental office will record the reduced fee on the claim form. For Gallivan Network dentists, the full fee as per the Provincial Dental Fee Guide should be recorded on the form, and the Network reduction will be applied afterward to the amount actually charged to the student.

Step 3: Submission & Payment

- ► Student is responsible for paying the outstanding amount.
- Dentist is responsible for submitting the claim to the insurance company for payment.

NOTE: The faster the claim is submitted, the faster the dentist will receive the reimbursement. The student is therefore not responsible for paying the insured amount in advance and will not need to wait for their reimbursement. This procedure is only beneficial to the student.

WITHOUT PAY DIRECT

Step 1: Confirm Coverage

Ask to see the student ID card.

Step 2: Fill Out Claim Form

▶ Dentist fills out claim form.

NOTE: The dentist must always indicate the total fee for the treatment as well as the dental procedural codes for the services provided on the claim form. The insurance company only uses the codes to process claims. For Studentcare Network dentists, the Network reduction must take place up front; the dental office will record the reduced fee on the claim form. For Gallivan Network dentists, the full fee as per the Provincial Dental Fee Guide should be recorded on the form, and the Network reduction will be applied afterward to the amount actually charged to the student.

Step 3: Submission & Payment

➤ Student is responsible for paying the total cost of treatment (after the Network reduction) and for sending the claim form to the insurance company for reimbursement of the insured portion.

For rapid processing, claims may also be submitted electronically.

Deadline for Submission of Claims:

Claims must be received by Canada Life no later than 15 months after the date the eligible benefit was incurred.

Claims must be received by ClaimSecure Inc within **90 days** of the end of the policy year in which the claim was incurred.

Claims must be received by Desjardins Insurance within 12 months after the service was incurred.

Claims must be received by GreenShield no later than **12 months** after the date the eligible benefit was incurred.

Claims must be received by Securian Canada within **90 days** of the end of the policy year in which the claim was incurred.

BLACKOUT PERIOD

FALL BLACKOUT PERIOD

Although the majority of coverage periods begin September 1, there is a Blackout Period for about two months at the beginning of the policy year (approximately September 1 to October 31). During this time, the insurance companies are not able to confirm coverage. They will not process or reimburse the claims of students who were not covered by the Plan up to the end of the previous policy year. Students who were covered by the Plan up to the end of the previous policy year are not affected by the Fall Blackout Period, while most students who were registered for classes by early August will experience a shorter Blackout Period. Any expenses incurred during this time can be claimed for after the Blackout Period, so long as the student is eligible for coverage.

WINTER BLACKOUT PERIOD

There is also a Blackout Period that affects new winter students beginning their studies in January. The Winter Blackout Period lasts about two months (approximately January 1 to February 28). During this time, the insurance companies will not reimburse claims for new students, as they cannot yet confirm coverage. Any expenses incurred during this time can be claimed for after the Blackout Period, so long as the student is eligible for coverage.

Students who were already enrolled in the fall are not affected by the Winter Blackout Period.

We recommend that dental offices not accept assignment of benefits during the Blackout Period.

POLICY PERIOD

Coverage is in effect from September 1 to August 31 each year.

DENTAL ACCIDENT

A dental accident is defined as "an injury to natural/healthy teeth from an external accidental blow to the mouth." Damaged teeth must be considered "sound." A sound tooth means a natural tooth that is not afflicted with any pathology either itself or in the adjacent structures. In addition, a tooth that has been treated or repaired and restored to normal function will be considered sound.

If a specialist is visited for covered services, the student's reimbursement will be processed according to the equivalent General Practitioner fee.

Coverage for dental accidents includes repair/replacement of natural teeth, including braces and splints to repair damage to natural teeth that have been directly damaged by the accident. To claim for dental accidents, treatment must be completed within the 12 months following the accident and the accident must have taken place while the student was already covered by the Plan. Claims will be rejected if the accident date was before the student was insured.

To be eligible for the dental accident coverage, the following documentation must be sent to the health claims department at Securian Canada, Designatins Insurance, Canada Life, or GreenShield:

- ▶ a letter stating details of the accident
- a treatment plan; pre-authorization stating work that needs to be completed as well as the time frame
- any other relevant documentation such as emergency room reports, x-rays, etc.
- ► Health Claim Form (available at www.studentcare.ca or mystudentplan.ca)

Dental accident coverage is reimbursed under the extended health coverage portion of the student Health & Dental Plan. Completed forms and all relevant documentation should be sent to the appropriate insurer.

Important note: Securian Canada

Claims **must** be submitted manually to Securian Canada to be eligible for the dental accident coverage.

A complete exam (sometimes called a new patient exam) is only covered **once per 36 months**. A complete set of x-rays or panorex x-rays is covered **once per 36 months**.

³The extraction of impacted teeth is considered to be part of preventive services by Securian Canada. The Studentcare Dental Network reduction, however, will be 20%, as this is considered oral surgery in the Provincial Dental Fee Guide for General Practitioners.

⁴ Fillings in amalgam (metal) are covered for all teeth. Composite (white) fillings are covered for the **front teeth and pre-molars only.** If the student chooses to have the back (posterior) teeth filled in composite, the claim will be reimbursed according to the amalgam fee.

⁵ Scaling is covered up to **2 units** per policy year.

Coverage Blackout Period

We do not receive student enrolment information until after the institution has confirmed the students are full-time and have been assessed the fee. Therefore, although coverage for eligible services is effective September 1st, the student is not active on the insurer's system until later in October. This means electronic claims processing is not possible until the Validation Period ends.

During the validation period we advise the students to expect to pay out-of-pocket. Please provide the student with a standard dental claim form. You can advise the student to visit the Benefits Plan Office on-campus about submitting their claim.


